**1.** Drew mentioned that God uses the difficult moments in our past to strengthen us for the pivotal moments in our future.

**\*\***What difficult moments in your past have shaped who you are today?

**\*\***What were your thoughts and feeling during those difficult moments?

**\*\***If you could write a letter to your past self, what would you say?

**2.** In the Biblical stories, God seems to always be sending people ahead of calamity so that his will would be done (Joseph to Egypt, Moses, etc.).

**\*\***How does this apply to us today? Does God send people in the same way?

**\*\***Who might God be sending you to (neighbor, friend, family, coworker, etc.)?

**3.** Read Exodus 3:1-4.

**\*\***Who appears in the bush, and who speaks from the bush?

**\*\***What other Bible stories take place on mountains next to plants, and how do they relate to each other?

**4.** Read Exodus 3:14-17, BUT every time you read “The Lord,” say instead, “he is.” (do that now...) This is what the name of the Lord really means: “He is.”

**\*\***What is God trying to tell the Israelites through his name?
