Acts 1:1-14

**1.** Drew opened his sermon by asking, “what are we building?” Take a moment to consider this. Everyone is building something...

\*\*What are you building? Is it yours or God’s?

\*\*What should your building look like?

**2.** In Genesis 1:26-28, humanity receives a mission from God to be fruitful, multiply, and fill the earth. They are also given dominion over certain parts of the earth as well. This mission could be described as “expanding the borders of the Garden of Eden.” In other words, God creates and orders things out of chaos, then gives humans the same responsibility: to bring order out of chaos and build things in and for God’s kingdom.

\*\*What are some Bible stories where good things are built?

\*\*What are some Bible stories where bad things are built?

\*\*What does it mean for you to expand the borders of the Garden of Eden? Think specifically of yourself, not your group or the church, just you.

**3.** Drew concluded by saying, “God reveals our HOW as we prayerfully seek him together.” Take some extended time to ask God, both as an individual, and as a group, “how do you want me/us to build your kingdom?” Do this before answering these questions.

\*\*What is one thing you can do right now to build God’s kingdom?
